Eduardo Blidner has been working as a professional photographer for over 20 years. An expert in all technical aspects of photography, he has done extensive commercial work for American and Argentine companies such as 3M Minnesota of Argentina, Mekro S.A., Santiago Distrifot S.R.L., and Casa Schwarz, among others. In addition, Blidner has been writer and editor of various important Argentine publications, and has written numerous articles for Kodak, Agfa-Gevaert, Ilford, Fuji, and another international companies.

In his personal work, Blidner has vastly documented Argentine themes that surround and inspire him in his native country. Landscapes, cityscapes, portraits of artists, dancers and performers are common themes throughout his work, all reflections of the rich beauty and unique Argentine flavour the artist sees and aspires to capture.
